- IT'S BASED ON AN ENVIRONMENTAL POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY The new General Plan is based on "Smart Growth" (aka "Sustainable Cities" or "Agenda 21") policies with base political assumptions that: Cars are bad. Single Family Homes are inappropriate and waste resources. And that driving your car on a freeway to work in a different city is bad for society.
- INTENT OF THE PLAN IS TO CHANGE BEHAVIOR Through re-zoning and regulations. Walking, bicycling, and the use of Public Transportation is promoted in lieu of car travel. You are encouraged to ride your bike to the Grocery Store and to Work. The new plan promotes building apartments and businesses close together so residents live in "Higher Density" neighborhoods where they can live, work, and play without leaving their "Village". This is part of a long-term effort to get Americans used to smaller lots, homes, vistas, resources, and expectations. A politically predetermined lower standard of living by design.
- THE PLAN'S VISION IS "ANTI-CAR" When Shannon Kimball, an urban planner hired by the city, talked about Upland's new plan including Foothill Blvd. she "explained the vision (for Upland) was no longer catering to the automobile; there would be a multi-use path along Foothill Blvd. to have pedestrians and bicycles utilize the street". All car use is to be reduced.
- **NO WATER** The drought has caused the valley's water agencies to issue a "SEVERE" water level alert. Upland is required to cut water usage by 36%, yet the City of Upland keeps building apartments and condos and plans to bring in 8000+ new residents. There's no water! Stop it!
- **HIGH DENSITY HOUSING** The Downtown Plan calls for developers to build up to 55 units per acre. 8th and Sultana is already being built at 29 units per acre. Traffic levels will rate a "D".
- HIGH DENSITY INCREASES CRIME The Downtown Plan includes building 1,158 units
 of housing which 874 will be low income! Current Upland Crime Statistics show that most crimes
 are committed in denser neighborhoods. Our police are already overwhelmed. The city has no
 money to hire more police and pay their pensions.
- NO INPUT FROM RESIDENTS -They held 4 workshops back in 2008-9.
- MUCH, MUCH, MORE increased congestion from "Higher Densities", not listening to residents, ignoring letters and emails, NO Town Hall, and the removal of the "Definition of Family" from the plan!
